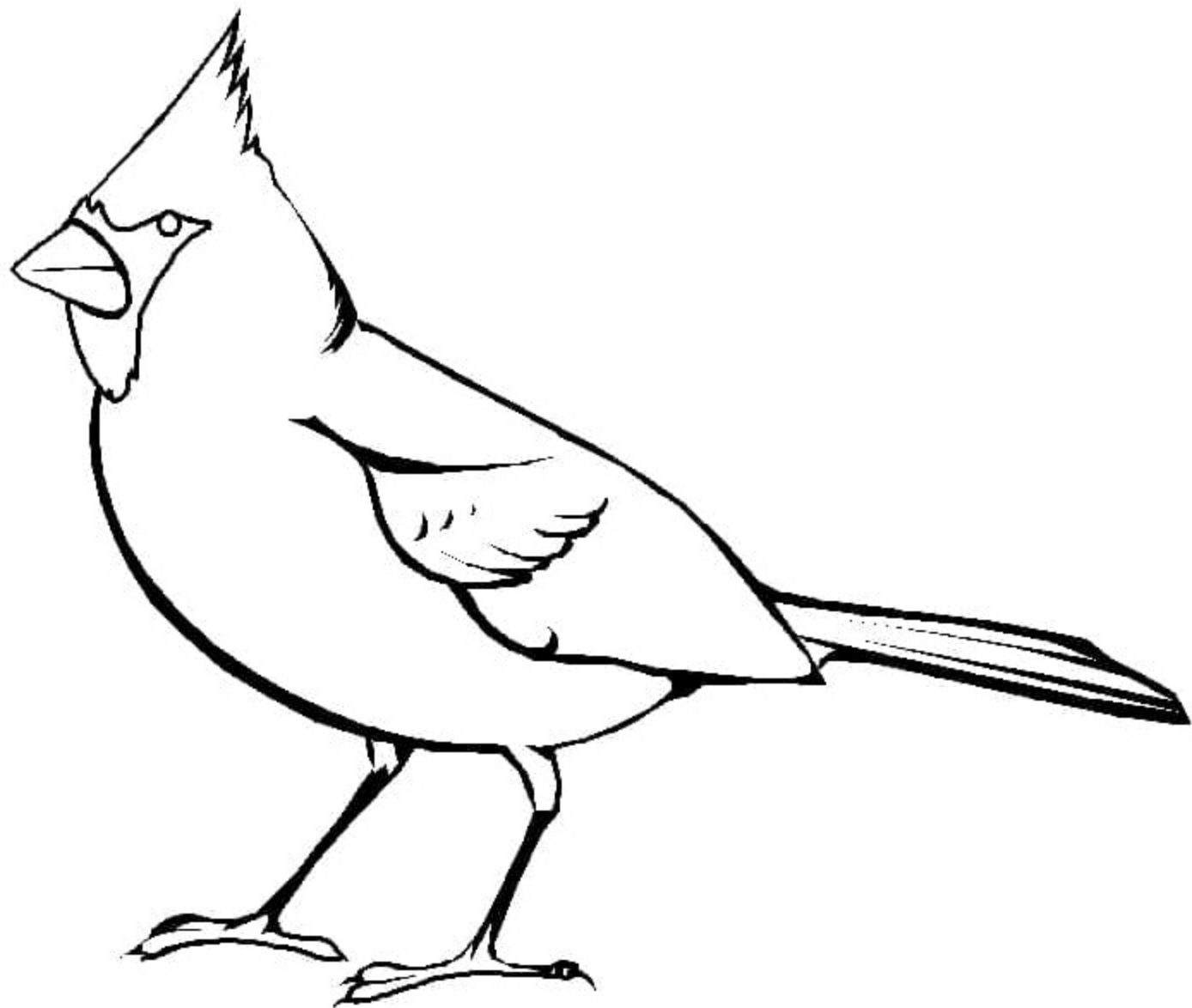




# Cardinal

- Cardinals lay several clutches of eggs each year. Each clutch has 2 to 5 whitish eggs with dark streaks and spots.
- The Cardinal was adopted as Ohio's state bird in 1933.
